- 1. Read pages 2 5 with a partner or in a small group. Experiment with different ways of reading: try taking turns; see whether you understand better by listening or by reading.
- 2. After you've read the assigned pages, discuss what you've read with your partner(s). Try to summarize what you've read.
- 3. You will see large blue-coloured headings. The headings in this section are:
 - a. Where does a worldview come from?
 - b. Introducing the Worldviews Icon
- 4. For each of the two headings, work with your partner to write a complete sentence that summarizes the contents of the section. You will have two well thought out sentences that summarize the information you read. Each member in the group needs to write down the information.
- 5. On the same page, replicate the table on page 5. However, do not copy down the information under the column "Possible Questions." Instead, write down the key **words** you see in each box. You may do this in point form. Consult with your partner before you write anything down. Your table will look like this:
