Visual Poem Assignment

A visual poem is a message that is sent in a visual format.

Objectives:

I CAN express myself creatively and artistically.

I CAN choose elements to symbolize an idea.

Instructions:

1. On the cover of your Journal/Workshop Book and your bookmark, you will create a piece of art that symbolizes yourself.
2. Before you start, create a web brainstorming ideas about:
 - a. Who you are – core values and beliefs
 - b. Your interests. Some ideas are:
 - i. Bands/singers/musical groups you enjoy
 - ii. TV shows you love
 - iii. Movies you've seen
 - iv. Activities you participate in
 - v. Sports you play or watch
 - vi. Prized possessions
 - c. Your family and friends
 - d. Your pets
 - e. Anything else that makes you *you*.
3. Decide your method of execution. You can draw, use magazine cut outs, or use another type of art. Prepare your art.
4. Glue your art to the cover of your Journal/Workshop Book and to your bookmark. Glue things down really well so they last all year!
5. Your journal cover must also contain your name, your homeroom, and the words "Journal/Workshops" in clearly visible letters. The bookmark should contain your name and homeroom.
6. Your teachers will let you know how long you have to work on this. Use your time management skills!
