Grade 8 Culminating Project: A Case Study

How do artifacts reflect a country or culture's worldview?

Overview: You will be creating a museum display including an artifact and a museum card, which represents the worldview of a selected country or culture, to demonstrate your knowledge of Worldview, and to demonstrate your ability to carry out an inquiry project. You will be presenting your museum display to your class and you will also have a chance to view museum displays from some of the other classes. This project, in essence, is your final exam for Social Studies and therefore is worth 5% of your final mark.

Objectives:


- I CAN demonstrate my knowledge and understanding of worldview
- I CAN research a country or culture
- I CAN use my creativity to represent elements of a country or culture's **current** worldview through an artifact
- I CAN analyse a culture or country's current worldview through critical and persuasive writing
- I CAN create a museum type display using my artifact, research, and persuasive writing to showcase my understanding of worldview to others
- I CAN demonstrate how history has helped shape the worldview of a country or culture.

Who: All Grade 8 students at Tom Baines working as individuals (No partners)

Process:

Part 1 - Selecting & Researching your Country or Culture

- 1) Select a country or culture that you are interested in. We encourage and challenge you to select a country or culture that you are not that familiar with.
 - a) Only one person per class can do each country or culture so make sure that you have a few as backup just in case the one selected has already been taken.
- 2) Now that you have selected a country or culture you can start your research.
 - a) All of your information must be based on the elements of worldview as shown in the two sets of graphs below:



b) You are encouraged to gather resources from a variety of sources including book, online, periodical, film, and interviews.

c) Your notes must be organized and done in the following format:

Source Citation (resource used)

- Amazing hand written, printed, or word processed notes in point form
- More amazing hand written, printed, or word processed notes in point form
- d) You must provide a typed copy of your reference list in proper APA formatting (Use APA Wizard or Citationmachine to help you with your formatting)
 - i) Internet sources must also be documented with a sentence explaining why the site is useful to your research. Internet sources must be in the following format:

• This site could be useful to my research as it presents information regarding several elements of worldview, including geography, and political systems of Ireland.

Part 2 - Artifact & Museum Display

1) Using all of the wonderful research you have found about your country or culture you are going to select one or two elements (social systems, culture, political and economic systems, geography, contact with other groups, ideas and knowledge) of its worldview to create an artifact as well as a persuasive piece of writing that represents these elements.

2) Artifact

- a) Design and create a 3-D artifact that represents the element(s) of worldview that you selected. If you chose to do two elements of worldview you should combine them to create one artifact that represents both elements.
- b) The artifact should be well thought out and planned, not something rushed and random.
 - i) Try to think of it as a visual metaphor that compliments your written work, and represents your country's worldview.
- c) How you choose to create your project is up to you, but keep in mind that it should not be unreasonably large but be creative and unique.
- d) You are responsible for bringing and providing all of the supplies that you will need to construct your artifact so plan accordingly as much of this will be done at school.

3) Museum Display

- a) Your display will consist of the following:
 - i) Your completed artifact
 - ii) Museum Ĉard
 - (1) Compose a critical and persuasive writing piece explaining how your artifact represents the element(s) of worldview that you have selected for your country or culture
 - (a) Without in-depth research you will not be able to represent the culture or country's worldview to the level you need to so make sure you spend sufficient time on Part 1.
 - (2) Information needs to be concise, effective and presented in a manageable format, with a title that reflects the artifact's main theme
 - (3) Presented on a museum card (approximately the size of $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$ of a piece of paper).
 - (4) Must be word-processed in size 12 Times New Roman, Arial, or Helvetica font.
- b) We recommend that you take the time to proofread and edit your writing piece as well as using peers to help you with this process.
