# All About Me

**Overview:** For this project, you will create a PowerPoint slideshow all about yourself to help your classmates and teacher learn about you. First, you will complete an outline, listing important information about yourself.

**Objectives (What you should be able to do by the end of the project):**

1. Find out about myself and others.
2. Recognize that diversity exists in the classroom.
3. Organize information in a way that makes sense.
4. Use technology to present information.
5. Make a presentation to my classmates.

5. Hobbies and Interests. List as many of your hobbies and interests as you can. Feel free to organize it in a web if you want to. This can include:
  - a. Sports
  - b. Extracurricular Activities (activities you do outside of school)
  - c. Things you do in your spare time
  - d. Things you like to do
6. Favourites. List as many of your “favourites” as you can. Feel free to organize it in a web if you want to. This can include:
  - a. Favourite TV shows
  - b. Favourite movies
  - c. Favourite actors / celebrities
  - d. Favourite bands/artists/singers/songs
  - e. Favourite books/authors
  - f. Favourite possessions (“things”)
  - g. Favourite colours
  - h. Favourite websites
  - i. Favourite computer games
  - j. Favourite \_\_\_\_\_ (the sky’s the limit!)
7. School. Include a story about school (At this point, you should list as many as you can and narrow it down to one later). Possibilities include:
  - a. A favourite school memory
  - b. Your favourite teacher
  - c. Your favourite subject
  - d. A funny thing that happened at school
  - e. What you’re looking forward to about junior high
  - f. Other
8. Something(s) about you that nobody (or few) people know. Also, think about who you are. What else do we need to know about you in order to understand *who you are* that hasn’t already been covered in this outline?

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# All About Me - Slideshow Organization

Now that you have brainstormed information about yourself that others should know in order to understand who you are, you will need to organize it in a way that makes sense.

In a PowerPoint presentation, the organization and order of your information is important so people watching the slideshow can easily follow it.

What you need to do now is plan the layout of your slideshow. In your slideshow, you **must** have between 10 and 15 slides of information. You must also include pictures and graphics, but if you decide to include slides of just graphics (and no text), this will not count towards the minimum required slides.

Here are the Requirements (Check them off as you go):

- ☐ At least 10 Slides of Text
- ☐ At least 1 photograph of yourself (bring one in or have your teacher take one of you)
- ☐ 5 images or graphics taken from the internet or the computer's clip art OR additional photos that you bring from home. Any images you take from the internet must be accompanied by a source (more information on this to come, but be sure you write down the web address of any photos you borrow)
- ☐ At least one slide on family
- ☐ At least one slide on hobbies/interests
- ☐ At least four "Favourites"
- ☐ At least one slide about school
- ☐ At least one thing not many people know about you

Before you actually create your slideshow, you should create an outline on the sheets provided.

Your homework tonight is to find some photos to bring to school tomorrow to include in your slideshow. You may bring them in one of two ways:

- Hard copies. You will use the scanner to scan them onto the computer
- Digital copies. You can bring them in on a disk or a CD or you can e-mail them to yourself (if you know your CBE e-mail address) or to your teacher (jplang@cbe.ab.ca)
- If you have neither of the above, your teacher can take a photo of you.

Next class, you will start working on creating your slideshow, so be sure your outline is ready and that you bring it to class!
